Community Powered Advocacy in Warwickshire

We want to reach a broad range of people at the earliest possible stage of their journey.

A person may have poor mental or physical health (or both), a disability – including learning disability and/or autism – or another health need. They may be older, be leaving care, be homeless or at risk of homelessness. These are just a few examples.

Aside from a low level vulnerability, each person we work with will be:

- > Either a Warwickshire resident or accessing a Warwickshire GP
- > Over the age of 18
- > Not in receipt or eligible for statutory advocacy provision
- > With low level support needs (both in terms of physical support and other complexities that require more specialist help).
